We wish to make clear our position released earlier today. We continue to strongly support the FCC's VoIP E9-1-1 Order and the need for the FCC to maintain its authority to enforce the rules adopted therein, including the November 28 compliance deadlines. In particular, we do not believe that a waiver of current FCC rules should be granted to permit a VoIP provider to sign up new customers or offer new service in areas where it cannot meet current FCC requirements.
