ENP Scholarship Applications**

Purpose of ENP Certification

Professional certification is used to establish benchmarks of performance that signify a broad based competency in the professional arena. By successfully completing the ENP certification, you will:

- Demonstrate a mastery of the comprehensive knowledge base required for emergency number program management.
- Help raise industry standards and increase the respect and prestige of those involved in 9-1-1.
- Confirm your commitment to the 9-1-1 profession by showing you are a leader in public safety.

Purpose of ENP Scholarship

1. To assist public safety professionals in reaching a higher level of knowledge of 9-1-1.
2. To provide financial assistance to 9-1-1 professionals who might otherwise be unable to pursue ENP certification.

Criteria

1. The applicant must meet the NENA eligibility requirements for taking the exam.
2. Applicants must be employed on a full-time basis by a public safety agency, 9-1-1 administrative organization, or official 9-1-1 planning board.
3. Applicant must not have received any TENA scholarship in the previous program year.

Responsibilities of Scholarship Recipients

Scholarship recipients must be able to sit for the exam at either the National NENA Conference or the TENA Conference. In the event that the recipient does not pass the exam, recipient understands that he or she will be responsible for re-examination at a cost of \$95.00.

Application Deadline

The ENP Scholarship Committee must receive scholarship applications by June 1, 2006. Scholarship recipients will receive written notification of their selection by June 20, 2006.

The ENP Scholarship Committee has final responsibility for determining the scholarship recipient for each region.
