Who should take this course? Anyone involved in public-safety communications who is now or may have responsibility to prepare disaster recovery plans for their PSAP.

This NENA course is designed to help the PSAP to plan for and most importantly to survive manmade and natural disasters that cause disruption to the overall operations of a PSAP. This course focuses on what all members of a 9-1-1 PSAP can do to get ready for and to continue to provide emergency communications during a disaster. This course gives an overview of possible related disruptions in the operations of a PSAP. Topics such as back-up procedures for system failures are presented in an easy to understand level targeted to the non-technical person. This course is presented in a related and informal setting and provides a straightforward approach to getting a PSAP started towards preparing themselves for disaster situations.
